“MATCH project peer group visit – summary”

Sport attracts European citizens, with a majority of people taking part in sporting activities on a regular basis. It generates important values such as team spirit, solidarity, tolerance and fair play, contributing to personal development and fulfilment. Sport involves people regardless gender, race, age, disability, religion, sexual orientation and social or economic background. Active and passive sport participation can contribute to this processes and foster teamwork, solidarity, tolerance and fair play in a multicultural context.

MigrA^tion and Spor^Ts - a CH^allenge for Sports Associations and Trainers brings together sport organisation from across Europe. Bilateral peer group visits, which are part of the project, provide the opportunity of in-depth discussions and

exchange ideas. The first visit of that kind was organised between Croatian National Olympic Committee and the CVS Broxbourne and East Herts on the 3rd and 4th April 2013 in Zagreb.

The visit was a great opportunity to meet some sport clubs, trainers, share areas of common interests and look at partnership work. The visit was also important as Croatia is preparing to join the EU in July 2013 and the project could bring “added value” for those working in the field of sport and integration.
